What is WINIPE?

WINIPE is a network for sharing ideas, IP academic resources, curricula, syllabi and experiences among participants from WIPO university partners with a view to strengthening cooperation among the WIPO Joint Master's Degree Programs. WINIPE was first proposed by the deans and directors of the WIPO Joint Master's Degree Programs in July 2019 at the Tongji International IP Forum.

The WINIPE platform was established by the WIPO Academy to share IP education resources and provide access to more than 170 e-books and publications with its academic partner institutions, professors, IP experts, students, and graduates of WIPO Joint Master's Degree Programs. WINIPE offers its members access to a networking space to foster a strong, global and digital community across generations.




What are the pillars of WINIPE?

The WINIPE mandate consists of four pillars:

- Lead IP education and skills development;
- Support academic collaboration and communication in IP;
- Pool academic resources on IP; and
- Promote the next generation of IP thinkers and leaders.
